Curriculum

The intensive short-term program provides students with an insight into the field of memory and identity in Eastern Europe and their impact on current political and social issues in the heterogeneous post socialist space. Different approaches and perspectives from the social sciences and humanities will be introduced and discussed between Estonian, Finnish, and German academics and students. The sessions deal with conceptual boundaries and new insights of "Memory" and "Identity", ethnic identities and the nation-state in Post-Communist Eastern Europe, identity constructions and the media, memory discourses and identity politics, and memory and identity in the context of World War II.
