In der Veranstaltung werden aktuelle Themen vor allem der russischen Volkswirtschaft und - bei ausreichendem Interesse - auch der Volkswirtschaften anderer osteuropäischer Länder behandelt. Als Diskussionsgrundlage dienen vor allem neuere Arbeiten der westlichen und russischen wirtschaftswissenschaftlichen Literatur (vorwiegend in englischer Sprache) sowie die laufenden Studien der einschlägigen internationalen Organisationen, wie IMF, IBRD (Weltbank), OECD, EBRD.

Hinweis: Aufenthalte des Dozenten in der relevanten Region seien „nicht im dienstlichen Interesse“ – so Präsidium und Verwaltung der FU Berlin. Der Dozent verzichtet daher seit einiger Zeit auf seine früher regelmäßige Präsenz insbesondere in Russland. Entsprechend lässt die Vertrautheit des Dozenten mit Vorgängen und Personen in der Region nach.
