## **GUIDELINES FOR THE SUPERVISION OF DISSERTATION PROJECTS**

Feel free to contact me concerning the supervision of your dissertation.

However, please be aware of the following rules, which might be helpful for you:

- 1. I am not particularly keen on supervising dissertation projects of students whom I do not know personally. If you have not been one of my students at least partly –, a personal appointment with me is indispensable. Please contact my secretary <a href="mailto:sekabpol@zedat.fu-berlin.de">sekabpol@zedat.fu-berlin.de</a> in order to make an appointment.
- 2. Before the personal appointment takes place, I require your CV, the overview of your studies and a proposal for your dissertation project of about 3 pages. This proposal should contain a research design based on variables. For details please refer to the information on my homepage regarding research proposals.
- Your research question may not to be normative. It also should not be closely linked with your biography. Additionally, I expect that your research question differs from the questions and topics dealt with in your previous academic work.
- 4. Please let me know the reason why you pursue a PhD and how you expect to finance your dissertation project.
