The case of Joachim Lelewel (1786-1861)

Part one: Poland on the turn of the historical epochs: from the end of the Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth to the beginning of modernity.

Last years of the Commonwealth (1788-1795); Situation after the partitions; Polish cause; Duchy of Warsaw (1807-1815); Kingdom of Poland (1815-1915); November Rising (1830/31); Great Emigration in France, Belgium

Part two: Joachim Lelewel: a biography (scholar, professor at Universities in Vilnius and Warsaw; politician before and during the November Rising; emigrant in France and Belgium)

Part three: between History and Ideology

A study of connections and interdependencies of Lelewel's vision of Polish history and his political programme, formed during the emigration; partly with the use of German translation of an early outline of Lelewel's Polish history (Geschichte Polens, Leipzig 1847).
