## OUR VISION

The Global Politics Summer School is a joint project between Freie Universität Berlin and Fudan University Shanghai. The partners pursue the objective of educating students in new approaches to global politics at the beginning of the 21st century.

The Summer School actively contributes to enhanced Chinese-German relations and strengthens the students' awareness of the important role of institutions in global politics.

While embarking on their careers in academia, administration, business, and media, the Global Politics Summer School alumni build a close network of committed experts, connecting China and Europe.

## PROGRAM COMPONENTS

Summer School Shanghai is an enriching learning experience. The program integrates

- state of the art teaching methods, ranging from interactive working groups to simulation games
- theory-based seminars complemented by practical modules, which activate students' potentials beyond purely academic topics
- a supporting program that offers visits to Shanghai-based companies, roundtable discussions with renowned international experts and excursions throughout the Shanghai region
- close cooperation with corporate partners, as well as with other public and private institutions.
