Ukraine's Agriculture: A Key Economic Driver

Agriculture (incl. up- and downstream sectors) generates:


- over 20% to Ukraine's GDP
- 60% of total Ukraine's exports

Recovery and reconstruction needs: USD **524 billion** (World Bank, 2025).

This is nearly 3 times Ukraine's projected GDP for 2024.

EU became a major trade partner of Ukraine - Exports


Ukraine's Exports, in billion USD

Agricultural goods dominate in Ukraine's exports to the EU






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
EU became a major trade partner of Ukraine - Imports

Example of European Solidarity Lanes (ESL)

- Scenario1. Weak ESL limited ESL capacity (12 mln t/year)
- •
- Scenario 2: Strong ESL full transshipment capacity of ESL (30 mln tons/year)
- Both scenarios assume no agricultural exports from Ukraine's Black Sea ports
- GTAP Version 7 CGE model and GTAP 11 database updated to 2021 (160 regions and 65 economic sectors)
